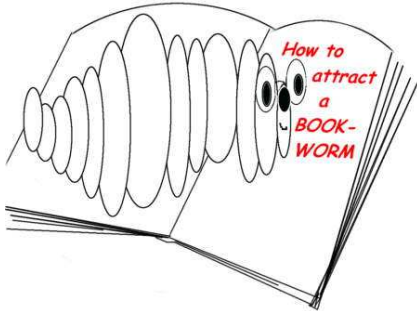


Tell us what you are reading!
